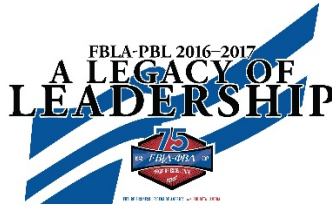

State Officers Candidates – Angie

Get your students thinking about running to be a state officer

Applications are due Jan 20

Students will receive study materials – must pass test with a 75% to run campaign

There will not be a Webmaster position as that position will be taken over by a state committee member

Reminder - If there are open positions after the Jan 20 deadline, an email will be sent and members will have 2 weeks to apply. If a member has already applied to be a state officer, they can't change their position. We hope this will allow us to have a full slate of officers before the SLC so all candidates will run a campaign.

Discussion – since we have gone from 7 to 6 state officers, we are considering changing policy so that each school may enter 2 state officer candidates and after the deadline if there are openings, a school may add a 3rd candidate. This may allow for more schools to be represented with a state officer.
