
A FBLA ANNUAL SURVEY

Annually, Iowa FBLA releases key data and insights on local chapter operations. The data is collected in two parts, consisting of an individual adviser survey and a chapter data collection survey.



CLASSROOMS

In the 2023-24 school year, Iowa had 325 school districts with 300 offering 9-12 education. Of that, 322 schools in Iowa offered a business program and 85 offered a information solutions program.



Typical schools consist of two individuals in the business and information technology department.

The average business department is teaching one course required for graduation.





21% of classes taught are dual enrollment or college credit courses.


FUNDRAISING
